



How does TLC Work?

Instead of going to his or her home school, your child will attend classes at The Learning Center. TLC staff will work with you and your child to develop a plan to support the development of skills your child needs to self-regulate and maximize their learning. Families also will work with a licensed social worker from St. Vincent.

What is a Typical Day Like?

It looks a lot like any other school day in the EVSC. EVSC teachers will teach the same subjects like reading and math. Students also will have lunch, recess and opportunities for physical activities.

In addition to these activities, your child will participate in programs designed specifically

to improve their executive functioning, social skills, and ability to regulate social, emotional, cognitive, and prosocial skills. If your child receives speech, physical or occupation therapies, he or she will continue those while enrolled in TLC.

How Long will My Child Stay?

Every child and family is different. The goal is to help your child develop the ability to self-regulate their emotions, thinking and social skills so they can return to a more traditional school setting. Their progress toward this goal will be monitored daily and shared with you regularly.

From day one, TLC staff will keep you updated on your child's progress. We will work together to talk through any changes. As your child is able to achieve his or her goals, we will also work with other schools involved to plan any transitions.

The TLC Family Partnership

As part of the TLC program, teachers and staff will meet with you every 8 weeks, or sooner if needed, to talk about your child's progress. The information you provide on how your child is doing at home will help him or her be successful in the program.

The Learning Center staff will also provide you with daily notes on your child's day and progress towards their goals. Signing those notes and adding your comments will help keep the information flowing.

TLC and Your Family

We believe family engagement is an important part of our student's success. Therefore we have partnered with St. Vincent's to provide social work services to families. A licensed social will meet with parents or guardians of students at The Learning Center. The social worker will help explain your child's support plan including understanding the reason for their challenges, ways to respond effectively and engaging in activities to strengthen the family.

The St. Vincent social worker will collaborate with your therapist, doctors or psychiatrists but will not replace their services. It is very important that you continue with any therapies since these services are not intended to replace those you are already receiving.
