In accordance with the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, Section 111(h) (6) Parents' Right to Know, this is a notification from the Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation to every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right to request and receive information in a timely manner regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers. This information regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers shall include the following:

- If the teacher has met state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas taught
- If the teacher is teaching under emergency or temporary status in which Indiana qualifications and licensing criteria are waived
- The teachers baccalaureate degree major, graduate certification, or field of discipline
- Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications
